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#### 1. Introduction

Faculty Development Programs at ASC went fully online during the pandemic year 2020-21. All ASC activities were mostly conducted online. To accomplish this, we created a fully integrated online FDP system, in coordination with Software Development Cell and Computer and Technical Support Services. Several new initiatives were taken up during this historic year digital transformation in teaching and learning.

Through action research approach, we conducted dialogues with stakeholders of the University to identify the bottlenecks and to transform ASC. The inputs were utilized to improve content, delivery and execution of faculty development programs across domains of teaching-learning, research, health and well-being, new technologies, industry, IPR and innovation.

All faculty of the campus were trained in the methods of online teaching, evaluation, assessment and conduct of exams. We also conducted special programmes to help faculty to make online classes more interesting, effective and interactive, as well as to safeguard themselves from cyber attacks while conducting online sessions. We achieved more than 16000 faculty registrations for our FDPs this year by improving relevance of FDPs, and through improvement in content, process innovation and digital transformation.

The faculty feedback received for all our programmes was highly encouraging. The resource persons were invited from premium institutions, industry and government from India and abroad, and it ensured that our faculty was in touch with development around the world during pandemic times. We also launched a multi-disciplinary weekend dialogue series on October 4, 2020 for all round and holistic faculty development and successfully completed these dialogues over 30 weekends.

Apart from FDPs, ASC also conducted online Faculty Orientation Programme for the first time in history of VIT University for the new faculty who joined online.

## 2. Highlights of Academic Year 2020-21

Pandemic year of 2020 changed the operations of every sector. This year acted as blessing in disguise for ASC. ASC launched their fully integrated online system, conducted 96 FDPs by collaborating with various schools at VIT and online Faculty was an additional feather to the cap. Enthusiasm was displayed not only by the ASC team but also faculties of VIT, wherein, 14000 plus faculties participated in various FDPs.


One-week FDPs was the highlight of this academic year. ASC conducted 19 one-week FDPs in the academic year 2020-21, with 1324 faculty participation.



#### 3. Faculty Orientation Program (Online) 8 June - 7 July, 2020

Faculty Orientation Program, a stalwart program of the Academic Staff College aims to aid the new inductees to understand the culture, the vision and the expectations of the University.

Adversities are always a blessing in disguise. This year due to the pandemic outbreak, digital platforms provided the channels of learning, and connectivity. The Faculty Orientation Program was conducted online and was scheduled from 8<sup>th</sup> June, 2020 to 7<sup>th</sup> July, 2020.

Director ASC coordinated with the Centre for technical Support and created MS teams ID account for all the new inductees. The schedule was prepared meticulously, looking into finer details and sequential flow of topics for FOP 2020. 60 topics were deliberated upon for the benefit of the 77 participants by 70 speakers. The participants joined from 100 places - all over India on the virtual space via MS Teams. Director-ASC welcomed the dignitaries and the new members of the VIT family warmly to the Online Faculty Orientation Program 2020. Though online, the FOP started with the traditional Thamizh Thai Vazhthu. Our Honorable Chancellor, Vice President and Pro-Vice Chancellor graced the inaugural ceremony. The Chancellor shared the vision of Vellore Institute of Technology, and inspired the 77 new faculty members to aspire for higher standards, collaborative learning and establish a good networking system with international and national peers. The vision of taking VIT to the Top 200 Global Universities List was seeded in the minds of the new faculty. Training programs in FOP 2020 were structured to envision this dream.

Our Chancellor addressed the new faculty during the inaugural session: FOP 2020





The Pro-Vice Chancellor shared the overview about VIT and transparently communicated the expectations of VIT. VIT nurtures talents and motivated each one to climb up in their career at VIT.





Director ASC during her ice breaking session got the faculty to know each other and set the ambience for a virtual FOP.





The Faculty were introduced to the HR policies of the institution by the Asst. Director HR. The Registrar shared his thoughts on the Journey at VIT. He invited the faculty to take on responsibilities and groom themselves as academic leaders. He also reiterated the idea that at VIT, it just takes committed work and talent with the right attitude to have a great career and progress at personal level also.





The faculty were then trained on MS Teams by the executive from MS teams. This session was to enable all the faculty to understand MS teams and be confident to use it. The faculty were then introduced to VTOP a software that gives access to information like course details, student information, assignment records, class attendance to access to study materials. The new achievement by ASC Director is that, with VTOP, the faculty will be able to submit their FDP requisition online.

Some titles that were deliberated during FOP 2020 were: Cyberspace Security, International relations, catalyzing innovation and entrepreneurship, trans-disciplinary research, online teaching, and the knowhows of academic regulations.

Disruptive research leading to innovation, creating time and focus on research, research regulations, writing proposals for funded projects, challenging experiments, executing projects, IPR and innovations at VIT stand proof to the fact that research is an important parameter at VIT. An **international resource person** from the University of Twente, Netherlands, Prof. Dr. Jos Van Hillegersberg inspired the faculty on writing review papers. The faculty were awestruck at the kind of support that is equally provided for faculty to continue their research passion, write and secure grants, execute projects and also for consultancy projects with the industry.

Curriculum design, PBLs, Coding procedures and practices, ppt with animations, flipped classrooms, virtual labs, AR and VR technologies, simulations and gaming for teaching, Bloom's taxonomy, setting HOTs question paper, question paper setting and mapping COs, rubrics in academics, story-telling in the classroom, University 4.0 stand testimony to the importance of teaching learning at VIT. The invitation to be a MOOC course owner kindled the interests of the new faculty and gained a lot of insights from the several sessions pertaining to academic interests at VIT.

Titles like exams and evaluations at VIT, experiencing digital evaluation, workplace etiquette, time management, and performance evaluation detailed all that a new faculty should know to function with ease and enthusiasm.

VIT houses students from across the globe. Effective classroom management, proctoring, and expectations from students made the FOP unique in itself.

The panel discussion by the deans and the directors was greatly appreciated by the faculty. This novelty was added to the online FOP by Director-ASC. The sessions as per the scheduled calendar were conducted smoothly. This was followed by reinforcement sessions till the 7<sup>th</sup> of July, 2020.

The faculty members were then grouped according to the schools. ASC coordinated with the heads of the various schools and facilitated a meeting of the faculty with their respective deans, which further nurtured the feeling of belongingness.


A virtual tour of the campus, the various schools, research labs, the library, the main building and the administrative block enthused the faculty.


# 4. One week Faculty Development Program














#### 8. Fully Integrated Online FDP System

ASC developed a Fully integrated online FDP system with the help of software and hardware teams of VIT.
