1. Introduction

Academic Staff College continued with Online programs during 2021-22 due to the Covid 2 and Covid 3 waves of Pandemic. A total of **41** Faculty Development Programs were organized with a footfall of **2935** participants. The 2nd Online Faculty Orientation Program was successfully organized during the month of June – July 2021 for a period of one month. 57 New faculty members were trained in the various domains of teaching research structures and history of VIT. A new initiative in collaboration with IIT Madras was launched in the form of Teaching Learning Workshops, one of such event was also conducted on campus in between the covid 2nd and 3rd waves window.

Elaborate effort was made to complete NAAC and IOE documentation, for 7 years from 2014 to 2021. The ASC team decorated the working space with illustrious postures, Flex boards and Flex sheets with summary of ASC activities. The Multi Disciplinary Weekend Dialogues touched the 50 Number mark since its launch on October 4, 2020. Extensive networking was done by Director, ASC to attract Resource Persons for various FDPs. She specialized in Universal Human Values program of AICTE and successfully completed the AICTE-Mentor Orientation Training Program organized by NITTTR (National Initiative for Technical Teachers Training) Kolkota and AICTE.
