Unbox, Decode, Design: Crafting Clues into Models

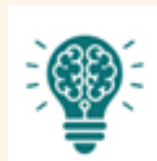

Scientific Poster Presentation

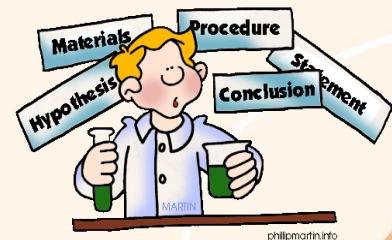
Something Remarkable Is Waiting To Be Known.
