S.No	Suggestions of IQAC meeting held on 29-5-2020	Action Taken Status
1.	Both students and faculty members to be provided training (Digital detox) to overcome the stress / fatigue experienced by them in online classes	<ul> <li>Suitable instructions were given to the students and faculty members to ensure that online classes are conducted smoothly.</li> <li>At least 15-20 minutes break is given between each class sessions.</li> <li>Students were advised to do short exercises involving eyes, neck and shoulders, so that digital toxicity does not harm their well-being and health.</li> </ul>
