Dr. G. Jayaraman, Coordinator (IQAC), welcomed the members present and briefed on the activities of the IQAC, during the last six months and the follow-up actions on the proposed plans during the last meeting.

It was informed the course files for the Winter 2013 – 2014 was audited and the reports were received by the IQAC office.

The members were also informed that the quality circle meetings were conducted during Fall 2014-2015 and the schools had taken necessary actions on some of the specific queries raised by the students.


The members were also informed that the institute is preparing for the third cycle of accreditation by NAAC and the faculty, student and staff were being sensitized about the NAAC peer team visit.

It was also informed that the university is planning for a major curriculum revision.


Coordinator gave a brief presentation on the research output of the University. As per the suggestion of the members during the last meeting, research output were projected school-wise, with inclusion of the citation index and impact factor.

Suggestions from the IQAC members:

1. During curriculum revision, the institute should emphasize on more of hands-on / practical experience rather than lecture based teaching. Also the curriculum should accommodate courses which will make students think innovatively and apply the engineering knowledge to solve the societal issues.
2. University should emphasize on research output, in terms of paper publication in peer reviewed journals and conference proceedings, per faculty.
3. Strategies to be evolved to attract more extramural funding. At the same time, amount of intramural seed grants should be raised.

1. To analyse the research publications in terms of citations / impact factor and this should be done school-wise and campus-wise. This will initiate healthy competition and would enhance the quality of publications.
2. To include external member in the evaluation panel for research. The member was informed that external members do take part in the evaluation of the research activities at various levels. This includes Research Advisory Committee, Doctoral Committee for the scholars and Thesis evaluators. Dr. C. Rajendran appreciated the efforts taken by the VIT University in innovative approaches in both academic as well as research fronts.
