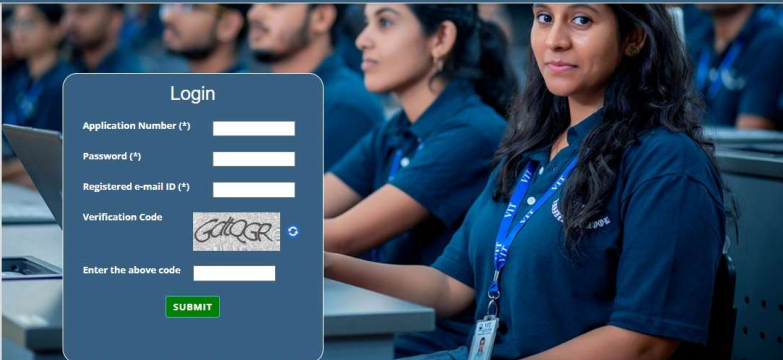
Step-1:

Important Instructions

1. The Admit card is an important document that must be safely retained and shown during the exam, interview and admission process.
2. Candidate should be present in the assigned exam centre at least 2 hour prior to the starting time.
3. The candidate should reach the exam hall at least 1 hour before the exam start time. Late arrivals will not be permitted to appear for the exam.
4. Biometrics like fingerprint and photo will be captured and will be verified again at the time of admission. Any attempt for impersonation will attract legal action.
5. Candidates should occupy only the allotted seat and candidates must sign the attendance sheet and Admit card in the presence of the invigilator.
6. The mode of examination is computer based test (CBT).
7. The candidate will not be allowed to enter the examination hall without the hard copy of the **VITREE Admit card**. Candidates are also requested to carry any one of the ID proof in Original (Voter ID, Postal ID, Passport, Driving license, Bank passbook etc.)
8. Candidate will be permitted to take the exam only as per the slot booked by the candidate while applying.
9. VITREE is a common entrance exam for Vellore, Chennai, VIT-AP and VIT-Bhopal Campuses.
10. Test Centre and slot timings cannot be changed under any circumstance.
11. If there are any discrepancies in the admit card i.e. (QP-code) candidate should email to researchadmission@vit.ac.in
12. The duration of entrance examination will be 2 hours. Examination will be from 10.00 am - 12.00 noon.
13. Candidate will not be permitted to leave the exam hall, till the end of the scheduled examination time, even if the candidate completes the exam, earlier.
14. Violation of any instruction or practice of any unfair means in the examination hall will make the candidate ineligible for admission.
15. Students are advised to use system calculators only. All other electronic devices/paper/log books are not permitted.
16. Candidate will be short-listed on the basis of their VITREE score, personal interview and weightage marks for UG degree/PG degree marks and the result will be published in our website: www.vit.ac.in on 20.12.2025 (tentatively) which will be intimated through SMS/Email to registered mobile number/email address.
17. Short-listed candidate will be called for an interview at the respective campus registered and the date and time will be notified later.
18. The candidate should produce this admit card at the time of admission and on demand whenever necessary.
19. Candidates who did not attempt any questions or scored zero marks in the VITREE exam will not be considered for further process.
20. Even though the candidates are permitted to write VITREE, candidacy is subject to the fulfillment of eligibility norms and verification of original academic certificates at the time of joining to the institute.

Step-4:

- Your printed hall ticket should contain the watermark as shown below.
- If the hall ticket is not in the specified format, you will not be allowed to take the exam.
