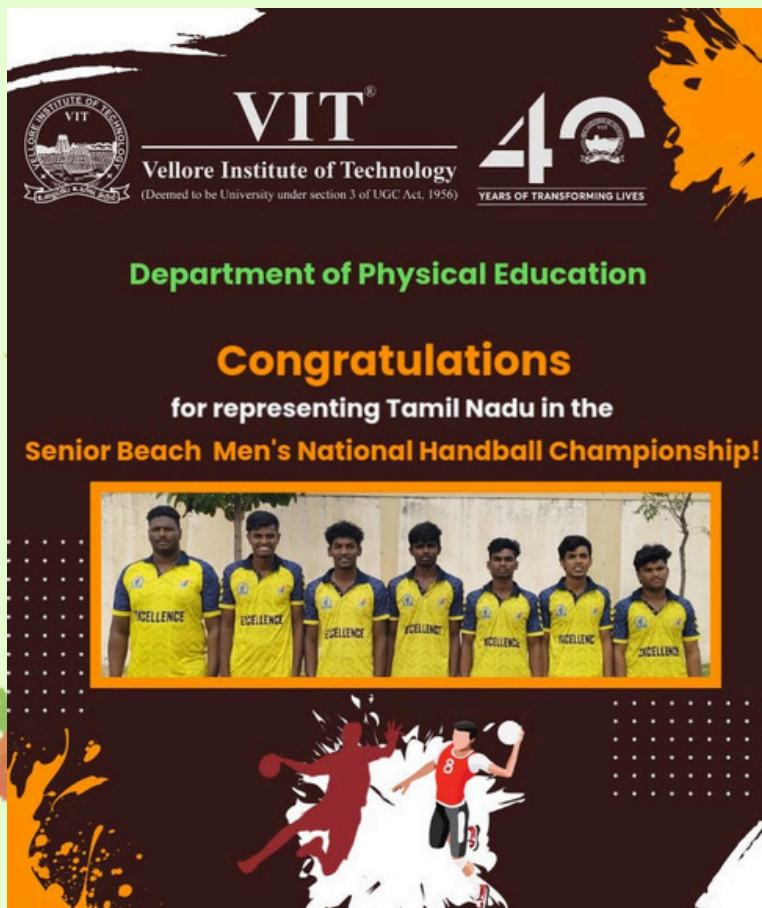

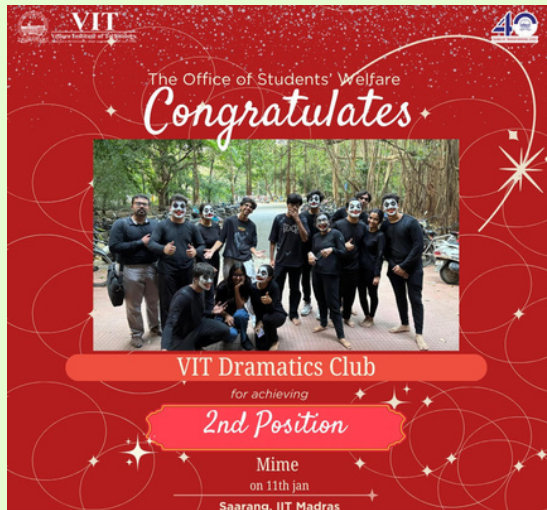

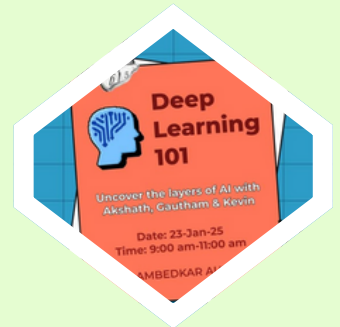
## AMERICAN SOCIETY OF MECHANICAL ENGINEERS (ASME) - BLOG FURY 1.15

## 4. ECOSTRESS Bolsters Ability to Predict Wildfires in Nature

NASA revealed on Jan. 10, 2025 — ECOSTRESS data indicates that among the leading indicators for the prediction of wildfire are estimates of water use efficiency, and because those are available with ECOSTRESS the data will indirectly measure vegetation plant-water dynamics, Klosterboer said. ECOSTRESS does not measure plant-water on a pixel-by-pixel basis so unfortunately for space the only information it can aster seismically inform and if at all adequately is to be fed back into models of fire susceptibility for natural resources management and public safety is how dry vegetation is under hotter than average years Klosterboer added.

## 5. Medical Innovation : Detailed Map Reporting Where All Proteins Reside in Human Cells

Surgery News: Scientists posted a complete map of the positions of human cells proteins, on 8 January 2025. This advance provides tremendous information on the functioning of cells and their responses to different conditions, including infections. At this level of detail of protein distribution could provide improvements in disease diagnosis and targeted therapy (personalized medicine) [European Society of Human Genetics 2008]. The changes shown in January 2025 updates from these developments underscore the continuing pace and success science and technology have made toward dramatic revision of our vision of the world, as well as our engagement with it. There is an endless potential for advances to be made as we keep on researching and discovering and that is why the future looks brighter than ever.

Look out for the next “Around The World”, where we will further investigate the newest and coolest sciences - and technologies.

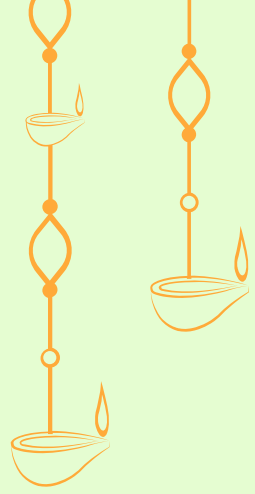

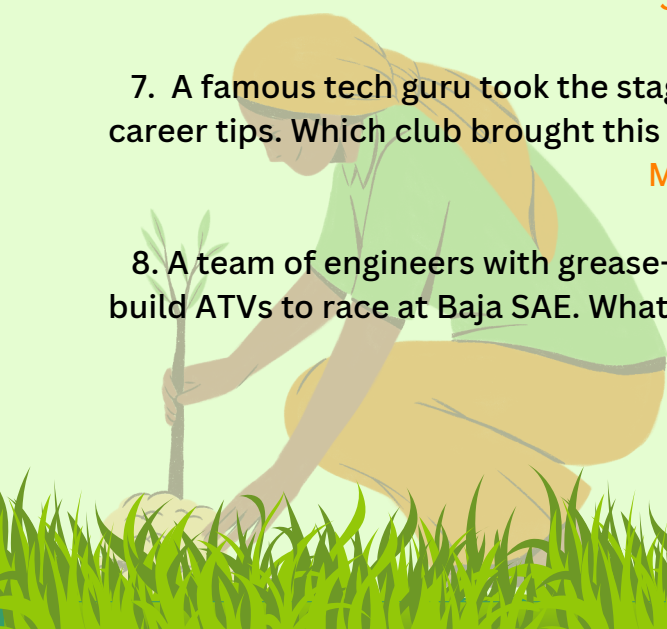

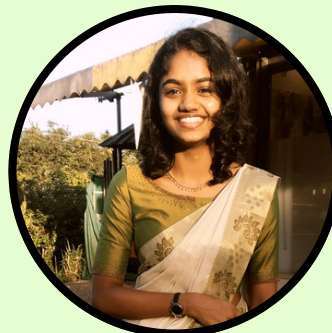
