WORLD NO TOBACCO DAY POSTER COMPETITION



The Council of Student Welfare is thrilled to announce the winners of our World No Tobacco Day poster-making competition. We received an impressive array of creative and impactful posters from various clubs and chapters, each highlighting the dangers of tobacco use and promoting a healthier, tobacco-free future. For the homemade poster category, E. Kaaviya has made an amazing poster showing us the consequences of Tobacco and all the side effects it brings along with it. VIT Amateur Radio Club (VARC) took home the winning poster in the Digital Poster Category.



JAMBUDWEEP PRAKADANAM

The Office of Students' Welfare organized a series of events and competitions across different clubs, celebrating the spirit of Jambudweep Prakadanam (Proclamation).



The PB Tamil Literary Association (PB-TLA) hosted an event titled "Ore Naadu, Ore Ilaku" to honor the Marudhu Brothers' memorial. A Google Meet debate focused on whether "unity in diversity" is just a statement or what brings Indians closer together, aiming to deepen students' national understanding and connection. The Fine Arts Club held the "Jambu Proclamation" poster competition, inviting Google Forms submissions reflecting the impactful statement that reshaped the Indian subcontinent. The best poster won a Rs. 250 prize, recognizing the artist's creativity and interpretation.

The Fifth Pillar held an online quiz on Quizziz titled "Maruthu Brothers' Rebellion: The First Cry Against British Rule," exploring their 1801 proclamation, protests, alliances, and impact against British domination in Tamil Nadu. The Hindu Education Plus Club hosted "Jambudweep Prakadanam Wordle" on Instagram, challenging participants to find themed words from given letters, with the fastest solver winning.

Ayuda organized "Voices of Resistance" on Google Forms, inviting 2 to 5-minute monologues about freedom fighters' courage. The best entry won ₹250. Anokha hosted the "Jambudweep Prakadanam Essay Competition" on Google Docs, inviting participants to explore the cultural and historical significance of Jambudweep. In a powerful move to commemorate The International Day Against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking, also known as World Drug Day, a dynamic poster-making competition was organized for students, igniting a wave of creativity and activism. The 2024 theme, "The evidence is clear: invest in prevention," inspired participants to craft compelling posters that vividly portrayed the vision of a drug-free world. Whether through digital art or scanned handmade masterpieces, students channeled their talents into impactful messages.

The competition called for entries to be showcased on Instagram, with participants tagging the official Instagram account of the Student Welfare Office to spread their message far and wide. The most striking poster, chosen by a discerning panel, would earn its creator a cash prize of Rs. 1000/-. With a midnight deadline on June 26th, 2024, the event spurred a vibrant community effort, encouraging students to engage their peers and spark meaningful conversations about drug abuse prevention and a brighter, healthier future.

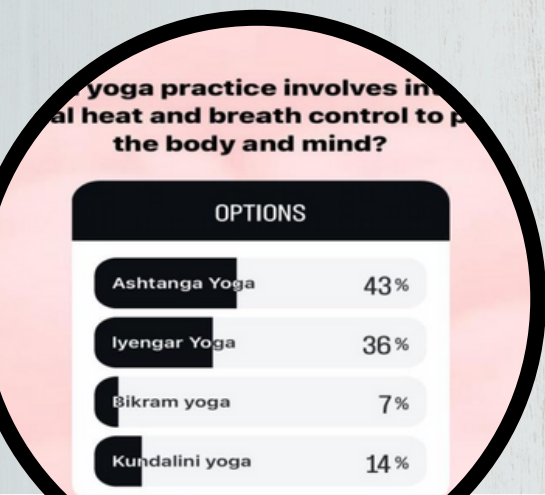
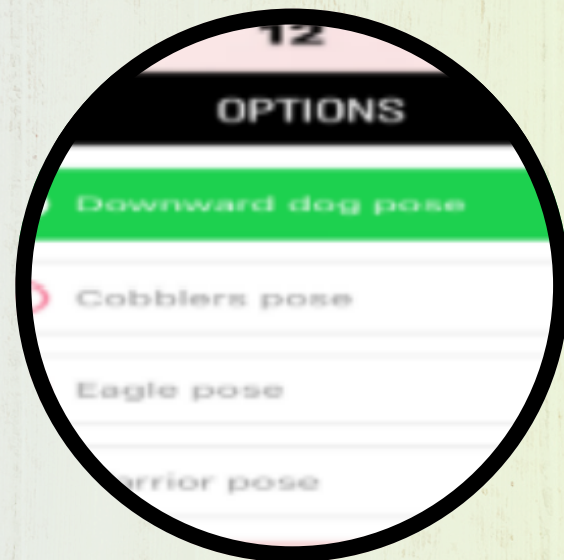


NO MORE TEARS

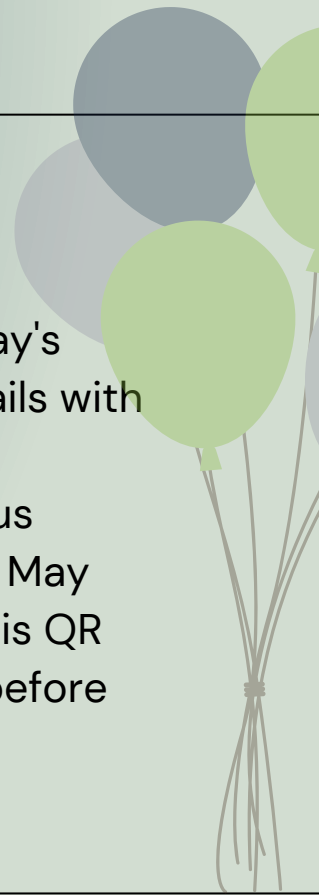
