Viksit Bharath

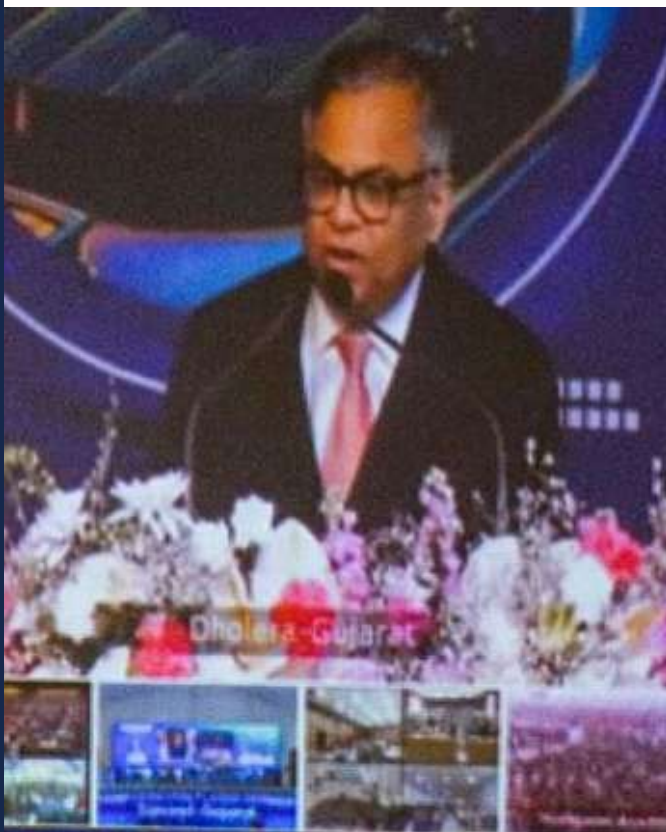

Prime Minister, Mr. Narendra Modi's live address, from the 'India's Techade: Chips for Viksit Bharat' event, electrified VIT Vellore's campus with anticipation and fervor. With over 120 participants in attendance, students, faculty, and dignitaries bore witness to history in the making alike.

The cornerstone of this endeavor was the unveiling of a semiconductor fabrication facility in Gujarat, alongside outsourced semiconductor assembly and test facilities in Assam and Gujarat, cumulatively amounting to an investment exceeding Rs. 1.25 lakh crore.

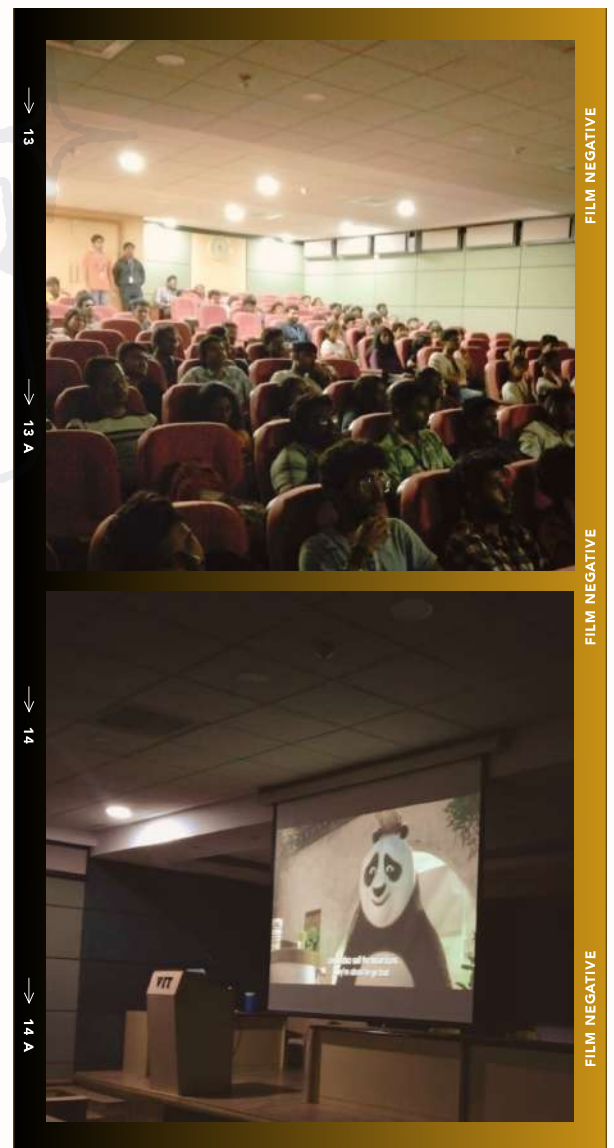
Movie Screening
