

Tech Niche 3.20 - "Large Language Models" IEEE COMPUTER SOCIETY (IEEE-CS) (CHAPTER)


The legacy Event Tech - Niche of IEEE CS, once again brought the opportunity for students to share their knowledge for a greater purpose. The topic was "Large Language Models"
