# 1. About VIT

VIT (Vellore Institute of Technology), established in 1984, was conferred with the status of a deemed university in 2001 by the Government of India. The main campus is located in Vellore, with additional campuses in Chennai, VIT-AP at Amaravati, and VIT-Bhopal at Madhya Pradesh, established as State Private Universities later on. # 2. School of Architecture (V-SPARC)

The V-SPARC School of Architecture, established in 2015, embarked on its journey with the inaugural class of 40 students and currently with 80 students. #### 4. Facilities

**Studio:** Architectural Studio is a unique feature in Architectural studies and its memory will remain forever for every Architecture student undergoing B.Arch Program. As it is evident that a student gets a hands on skill, working through the course, his expertise and skills are developed on the drawing board, where he does the work such as drawings or making models or doing his art works. For all these different types of works, an Architecture Student has his own space within the class room that is his own creative 'Den' which facilitates that growth from a novice into a graduate in Architecture. This space is more often collectively called as the Studio from the early 1900s, since the inception of Architecture studies and curriculum.

**Classrooms:** The classrooms are well designed rooms that incorporate everything needed for a pleasant learning atmosphere. The wide spacious classrooms contain a white board and also a projector that is used for teaching so a professor can switch to different modes of teaching as and when required so the teaching isn't monotonous and the lectures are put across in the best way possible. This hi-tech equipment enables our faculty to conduct classes in a way that enable students to make use of every available resource from one point at the click of a button. These classrooms are also often used for seminars and events from time to time.

## **5. Selection Procedure (NATA)**

Selection is based on valid NATA score and 10+2 marks in the qualifying Examination

- The NATA (National Aptitude Test in Architecture) is a national level aptitude test organized by Council of Architecture. This exam is organized for those aspirants looking for admission in architecture courses like B.Arch offered by top institutions of the country. This test measures the aptitude of the candidate for the field of architecture.
- Applicants seeking admissions for B.Arch in VIT, Vellore campus should qualify through NATA.
   Please refer the website www.nata.in for filling NATA online application. NATA score card is mandatory for admission in B.Arch. programme.

# 6. Eligibility

#### 6.1 Nationality

The applicant should be either a Resident Indian National or a Non-Resident Indian National.

#### 6.2 Age Limit

- Applicants born on or after 01.07.2002 are eligible to apply for B.Arch admission for the acedamic year 2024.
- Applicants must present the original birth certificate as proof of their age during counselling/ admission. Failure to do so will result in disqualification from the admission process.

#### 6.3 Qualifying Examination

- The final examination must be from the 10+2 system of Higher Secondary Examination conducted by the State Board, Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE, New Delhi), or The Council for Indian School Certificate Examination (ISCE, New Delhi), Intermediate, or Two-year Pre-University Examination conducted by a recognized board/university, or an equivalent examination.
- NIOS Board and Open schools recognized by JEE are acceptable.
- Students who have appeared for their standard XII examination and are awaiting results are also eligible to apply, provided they submit their passing certificate by the notified date.

#### 6.4 Subject Eligibility in the Qualifying Examination

- A pass in 10+2 with an overall aggregate of 60% with Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics (PCM) as compulsory subjects and valid NATA score.
- In case, applicant belongs to SC/ST community or hail from Jammu and Kashmir/ Ladakh and the North Eastern States of Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Sikkim and Tripura, 10% relaxation is provided (i.e.,) 50% minimum aggregate as per the condition, in the qualifying examination mentioned above.

#### 7. Admission Procedure

- Merit list will be prepared on the basis of 10+2 marks and valid NATA score
- The shortlisted applicants will be called for counselling (virtual/physical)
- The fact that a candidate has qualified and has been called for the counselling does not guarantee admission to him / her.

# 8. Online Application Form

Applications must be submitted online via the website:

- Candidates should register with a valid email ID and mobile number, as all correspondence will be communicated through these registered email/mobile number only.
- The application cost is Rs.1350, and it is non-refundable.

#### Steps to be followed for online application:

- Step 1: Register yourself by clicking on "New applicant."
- Step 2: Verify your registered email address by using the OTP received from VIT.
- Step 3: Once OTP is validated, a password will be sent to your registered email address. Keep this email ID and password secure until the admission process is complete.
- Step 4: Fill out the application form online using Net banking, Debit card, Credit card, or Paytm.
- Step 5: Pay the non-refundable application fee of Rs.1350.
- Step 6: Upload Age proof certificate, 12th Mark sheet, NATA score card

# Applicants are required to upload the below mentioned documents on the application portal (based on availability within the time frame)

- Copy of Age proof certificate / Copy of Aadhar Card
- Copy of XII Hall Ticket (for applicants awaiting results)

- Copy of XII Mark statement (for all attempts)
- Copy of NATA score card

- Copy of Nativity Certificate (For applicants hailing from North Eastern States and Jammu & Kashmir/ Ladakh)

# 9. Declaration of Results

• The results of shortlisted candidates will be announced. Shortlisted candidates will then be invited for online counselling.

# 10. Online Counselling Procedure

- BEING CALLED FOR ONLINE COUNSELLING DOES NOT GUARANTEE A SEAT.
- Seat allotment is based on the candidate's rank, and seat availability.
- Details regarding seat allotment, instructions for admission fee payment, and downloading the allotment letter will be communicated to candidates through the counselling portal.
- Provisional admission will be cancelled if the candidate does not meet the eligibility norms.

#### 13. Withdrawal Procedure

- Candidates can request withdrawal either online or by submitting in person.
- The necessary form for withdrawal/clearances must be obtained to facilitate the withdrawal process.
- The withdrawal application date is considered as the date of submitting the clearance form.
- Refund will be processed through account transfer to the bank account mentioned in the withdrawal request. Accurate bank account details must be provided.
