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1. About VIT

4. Facilities

VIT School of Design (V-SIGN) is one of the newest schools in VIT, Vellore. It has been functional from July 2018 and currently B.Des and M.Des programmes in the branch of Industrial Design are being offered by this new school. It offers one of the best facilities for design research, consultancy, training and growth for faculty members. The main objective of the programmes is to create a new breed of problem solvers in the domain of industrial design.

Already state-of-the-art studio / lab facilities have been created in a sprawling new building for teaching, training, model-making, prototyping, and experimenting. PROTICS Studio (PROduct aestheTICS), 3D-iD Studio with 30 iMacs, Smart PD Lab, Ergonomics Lab, anad Painting Booth are some more facilities already established.

5. Selection Procedure (UCEED/V-DAT (VIT-DESIGN APTITUDE TEST)

Selection is based on valid UCEED score/V-DAT (Design Aptitude Test) score with 10+2 marks in the qualifying Examination

5.1. UCEED I

- UCEED (Undergraduate Common Entrance Exam for Design) Score will be considered for admissions to the B.Des. (Industrial Design) program.

5.2. V-DAT (VIT-DESIGN APTITUDE TEST)

VIT DAT is the exam for the candidates who have not attended UCEED exams or not having valid UCEED score or disqualified in UCEED.

The selection process consists of three stages:

- VIT DAT written exam of 2 hours duration consisting of objective type questions MSQ & MCQ, short descriptive answers, and creative ability questions with no negative marking (Weightage 50%)
- Portfolio presentation of original creative works like sketching, drawing, painting, craft works, and photography, etc. (Weightage 30%)
- Personal interview (Weightage 20%)

6. Eligibility |

6.1 Nationality

The applicant should be either a Resident Indian National or a Non-Resident Indian National.

6.2 Age Limit

- Applicants born on or after 01.07.2002 are eligible to apply for B.Des admission for the academic year 2024.
- Applicants must present the original birth certificate as proof of their age during counselling/admission. Failure to do so will result in disqualification from the admission process.

6.3 Qualifying Examination

- The final examination must be from the 10+2 system of Higher Secondary Examination conducted by the State Board, Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE, New Delhi), or The Council for Indian School Certificate Examination (ISCE, New Delhi), Intermediate, or Two-year Pre-University Examination conducted by a recognized board/university, or an equivalent examination.
- NIOS Board and Open schools recognized by JEE are acceptable.
- Students who have appeared for their standard XII examination and are awaiting results are
 also eligible to apply, provided they submit their passing certificate by the notified date.

6.4 Subject Eligibility in the Qualifying Examination

- A pass with minimum overall aggregate of 60% in any stream in the qualifying examination.
- In case, applicants belong to SC/ST community or hail from Jammu and Kashmir/ Ladakh and the North Eastern States of Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Sikkim and Tripura, 10% relaxation is provided (i.e.,) 50% minimum aggregate as per the condition, in the qualifying examination.

7. Admission Procedure

- Merit list will be prepared on the basis of 10+2 marks and valid UCEED score/10+2 marks and performance in VIT-DAT score (VIT-Design Aptitude Test)
- The shortlisted applicants will be called for counselling (virtual)
- The fact that a candidate has qualified and has been called for the counselling does not guarantee admission to him / her. This depends upon the availability of seats.

8. Online Application Form

- Applications must be submitted online via the website: https://admissions.vit.ac.in/bdes-industrial-design-2024-applications
- Candidates should register with a valid email ID and mobile number, as all correspondence will be communicated through these registered email/mobile number only.
- · Application cost is Rs.1350/- and it is non-refundable.

Steps to be followed for online application:

- Step 1: Register yourself by clicking on "New applicant."
- Step 2: Verify your registered email address by using the OTP received from VIT.
- **Step 3:** Once OTP is validated, a password will be sent to your registered email address. Keep this email ID and password secure until the admission process is complete.

- **Step 4:** Fill out the application form online using Net banking, Debit card, Credit card, or Paytm.
- **Step 5**: Pay the non-refundable application fee of Rs.1350.
- Step 6: Upload age proof certificate, 12th markstatement, UCEED score card (If available).

Applicants need to upload the following mentioned documents on the application portal, subject to their availability within the specified timeframe.

- · Copy of Age proof certificate / Copy of Aadhar Card
- Copy of XII Hall Ticket (for applicants awaiting results)
- Copy of XII Mark statement (for all attempts)
- · Copy of UCEED score card (If available)
- Copy of Community Certificate (for SC/ST applicants)
- Copy of Nativity Certificate (For Applicants hailing from North Eastern States and Jammu & Kashmir/ Ladakh)

9. Declaration of Results

• The results of shortlisted candidates will be announced. Shortlisted candidates will then be invited for online counselling

10. Online Counselling Procedure

- BEING CALLED FOR ONLINE COUNSELLING DOES NOT GUARANTEE A SEAT.
- · Seat allotment is based on the candidate's rank, and seat availability.
- Details regarding seat allotment, instructions for admission fee payment, and downloading the allotment letter will be communicated to candidates through the counselling portal.
- · Provisional admission will be cancelled if the candidate does not meet the eligibility norms.

13. Withdrawal Procedure

- Candidates can request withdrawal either online or by submitting in person.
- The necessary form for withdrawal/clearances must be obtained to facilitate the withdrawal process.

- The withdrawal application date is considered as the date of submitting the clearance form.
- Refund will be processed through account transfer to the bank account mentioned in the withdrawal request. Accurate bank account details must be provided.
