Registration rules:

1. Re-registrations are permitted for N1, N3 and F grades only. N2 and N4 are not permitted.
2. ADD/DROP or Withdraw options are not available.
3. Fresh registrations are not permitted (under regular, additional, audit, substitution and others)
4. Timed-out students can avail either arrear option (refer to circular from CoE) or re-register for the course in this intersemester, but not both.
5. Courses registered during the Fall Semester / Fall Weekend Intrsemester 2020-2021 cannot be registered during the intersemester.
6. Timed out students are permitted to register for fresh courses in the regular mode. Registrations under audit or additional course types are not permitted.
7. In general, number of courses that can be registered is as per the availability of the slots.
8. Though sufficient steps will be taken by the School to offer / facilitate registration of the courses, as given in the student wishlist, courses will be offered depending on the availability of the resources.
9. Regular slot system (as in Fall Semester 2020-2021), with a different slot combination, will be followed.

Note:

1. Saturdays are working days. Day order will be reflected in VTOP.
2. Laboratory FAT will be conducted during the last laboratory instruction class (as per slot).
3. Information on theory FAT will be informed later.
4. Classes and continuous assessments will be conducted through online mode, till further notice.
5. The Academic Calendar is subject to change depending on the pandemic situation.
