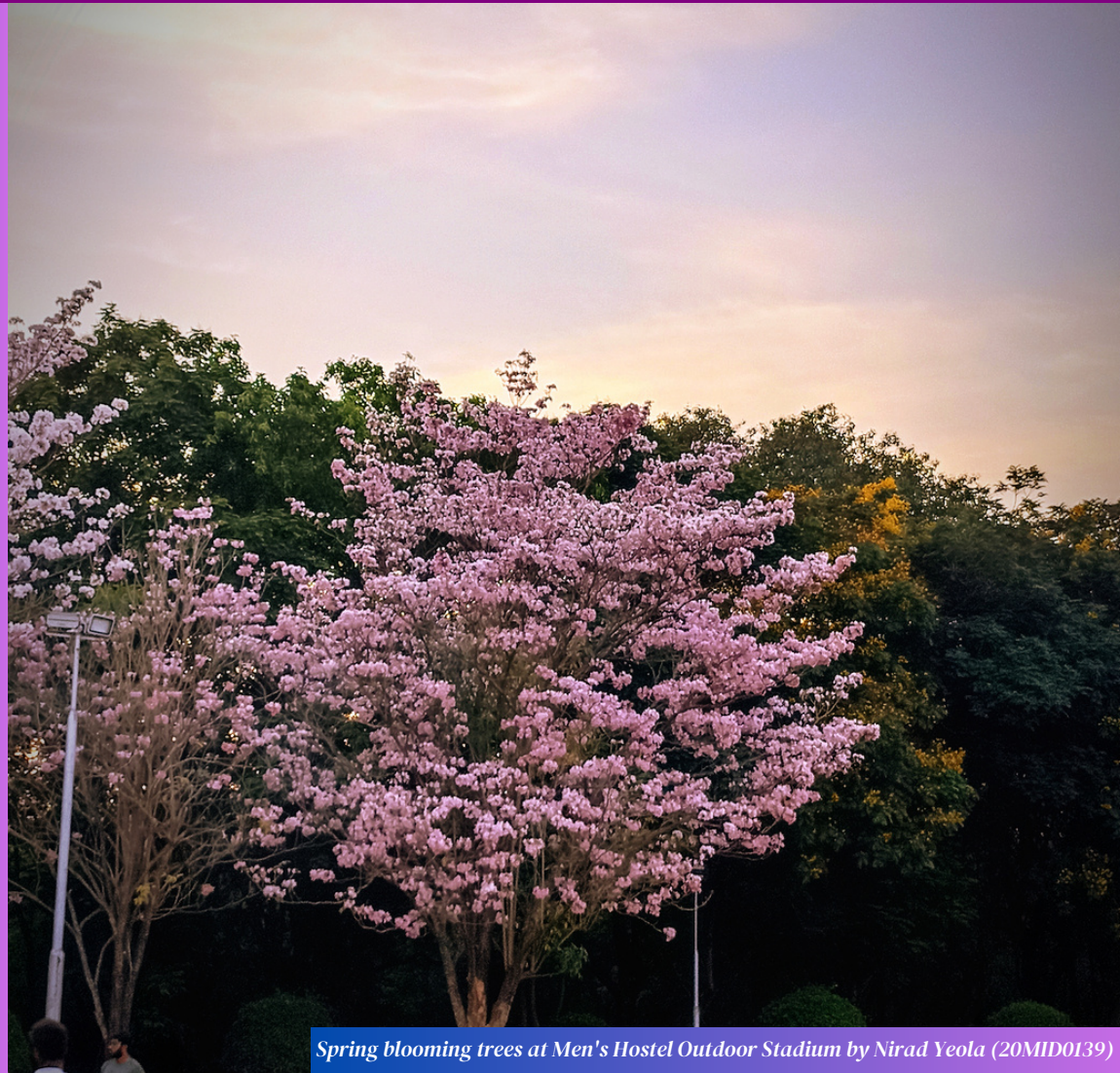

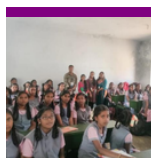

NSS Special Camp

NSS (National Service Scheme) Special camp was conducted by the Vellore Institute of Technology between 2nd March 2023 and 8th March 2023 in sixteen villages in and around Thiruvalam belonging to the Katpadi Block. 305 student volunteered from the sixteen states across India including 163 male students and 142 female students.



Activities Held:

- Veterinary camp was arranged at Sevoor in coordination with Tamil Nadu Veterinary Department on 4th March 2023, that contributed to the treatment of 157 animals.
- Mushroom cultivation training in collaboration with VIT School of Agricultural Innovations and Advanced learning (VAIAL) was organized in Sevoor village on 5th of March 2023. Totally forty villagers were benefited in this scheme
- Veterinary camp was arranged at Kemparajapuram in coordination with Tamil Nadu Veterinary Department on 6th March 2023. With their support and coordination of students, treatment was provided to 87 animals.
- Training on Fast food preparation was arranged in co-ordination with School of Hotel and Tourism Management, VIT at Arumparuthi village of Tamil Nadu on 7th March that benefited 80 individuals.
- Soil and water testing was conducted in coordination with School of Agriculture VIT at different farms in Kemparajapuram village of Tamil Nadu on 7th March.
- A special medical camp was arranged at Thiruvalam in coordination with Sri Narayani Hospitals on 8th March 2023 during the camp. 154 patients were examined and provided with primary treatment.

Various teams of camp :



Higher Secondary Team: The team educated the various opportunities available for the students after completing higher secondary. Team conveyed the details of entrance exams available and what are the procedures to apply for the exams and their admission procedures.

Survey: Higher education details was collected, that covered nearly 1300 families in 12 villages.

Road safety Team: Explained the school children about road safety, in matters like how should they act on the road while walking and travelling in bus, car and other vehicles.

Cleaning Team: Cleaning of 8 school premises, and Thiruvallur primary health centre was carried out.
Renovated the 25th Anniversary of Independence memorial.



Primary school Team: Interacted with the school students and entertained them with indoor games.

Food Committee Team: Responsible for serving food in the camp.

Explained the importance of millets, cereals, grains, and good food habits.



Tree Plantation Team: A total of 150 saplings were planted in 6 school premises.

Medical Team: Encouraged the school students to get involved in sanitary activity by teaching disease free environment, health awareness and clean habits.

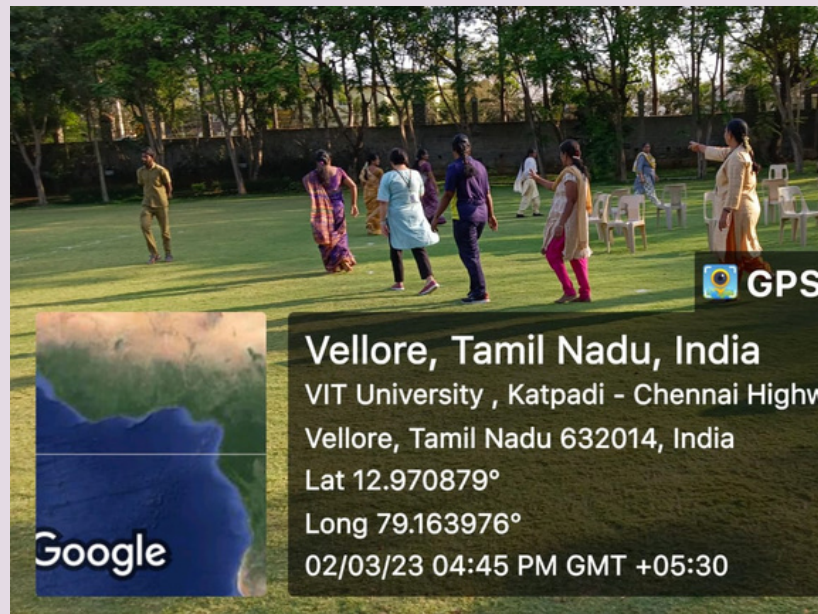

On Saturday, 11th of March 2023, the Office of Students' Welfare organized the Vellore heritage trip for 2022 batch foreign students. Students along with faculty member visited the historic golden temple located inside the Sripuram spiritual park at the foot of a small range of green hills at Thirumalaikodi, Vellore. The students enjoyed the beauty and aura of the temple and were stunned on seeing the hand-carved golden exterior.

It is mentioned that "there is no such fort on the face of earth like the one in Vellore. The fort is considered to be amongst the best examples of military architecture in Southern India and is known for its grand ramparts, wide moat and robust masonry. The Jalagandeeswarar Temple, dedicated to Jalagandeeswar, (the original name of the deity was "Jwarakandeeswarar") is noted for its sculptures, and speaks volumes of the exquisite craftsmanship of the highly skilled



Goddess is also called 'Sri,' and so her abode here has come to be known as Sripuram. Hence this unique place of worship is popularly known as both the Vellore Golden Temple and the Sripuram Golden Temple.

Vellore is a historic town. The grand Vellore Fort and the ancient Jalakandeswarar temple located in it bear testimony to the place of pride that the town occupies in the Indian historical map.

The Heritage Visit Vellore was a memorable and enriching experience. It gave us a glimpse into the rich cultural heritage of the region and allowed us to appreciate the architecture and purpose of the golden temple and the Vellore fort.

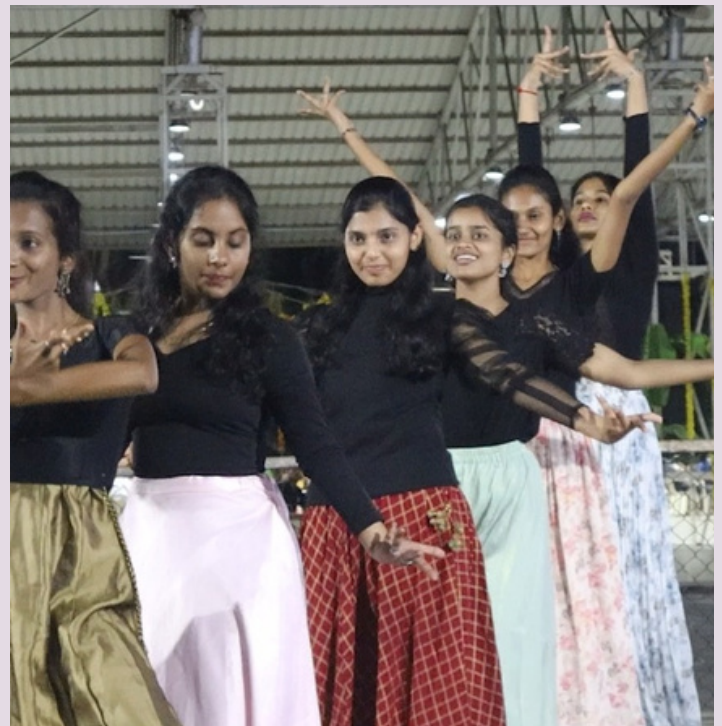

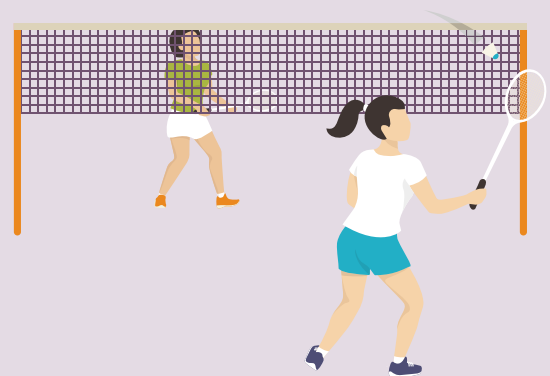

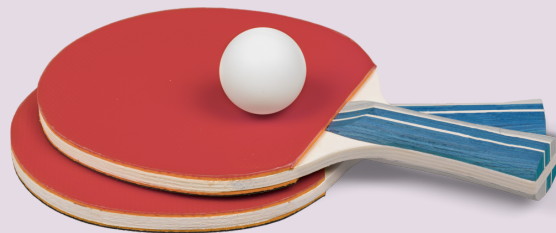
