Inspired by our **honorable chancellor, Dr. G. Viswanathan** and motivated and guided by our **beloved Vice President, Mr. G. V. Selvam**, the volunteers of VIT- Youth Red Cross along with our faculty coordinator, **Dr. V. Suneetha and Dr. Venkateshwarlu B** distributed **blankets** to the underprivileged sleeping by the roads at night **between 12 AM to 1:15 AM**. On the way from VIT Campus to the New bus stand, they distributed **a total of 22 blankets** to those in need. Following this, at the **New bus stand**, they distributed a total of **5 blankets**. On the way from the **New bus stand to Katpadi railway station**, another **4 blankets** were distributed to those who were left unsheltered in the cold.
