The School of Bio Sciences and Technology consists of four departments namely Biotechnology, Integrative Biology, Bio Sciences and Bio-Medical Sciences. The school offers an undergraduate (B.Tech. Biotechnology), four post-graduate (M.Sc. and M.Tech), and two integrated postgraduate (M.Sc.) and Ph.D programmes. As per the National Education Policy, multiple entry and exit options are made available in the Integrated PG programmes. In addition to the regular programmes, specialisations are available in prominent areas. In addition to the regular curricular structure, the schools provides ample opportunities to expose the students in current research developments and to the requirements of the industries. Faculty members of SBST carry out both fundamental as well as translational research with a focus on providing sustainable solutions and offer consultancy services to various industries. The school boasts of having published 6000+ research and review articles with a h-index of 97; granted 55 patents.
