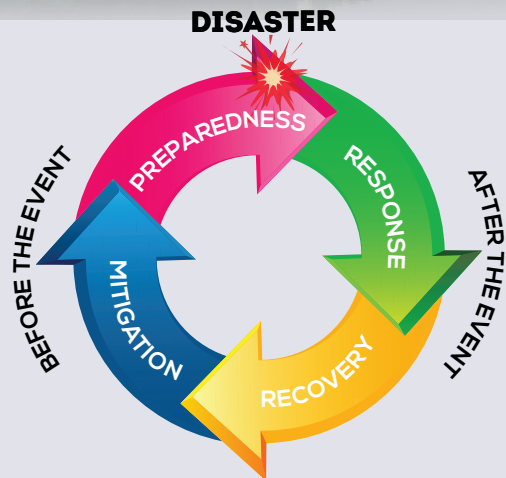
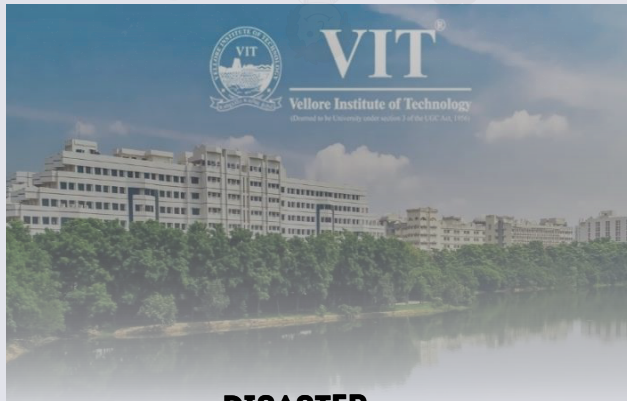


## About Workshop
