About Vellore Institute of Technology

Vellore Institute of Technology (VIT) was founded in 1984 as Vellore Engineering College by Chancellor Dr G. Viswanathan. VIT attracts students from all 29 states of India and more than 41 different countries because of its academic excellence. VIT was established with the aim, of providing quality higher education on par with international standards. VIT has been constantly ranked among the best universities and is aspiring to emerge as a global leader. VIT has already been ranked by major international rankings by agencies such as Shanghai ARWU Ranking, QS, Times Higher Education, US News, RUR, and others. Seven subjects of VIT are within the top 450 QS World University Rankings by Subject. VIT has ten research centers in futuristic areas and has 300+ global academic partnerships in operation.

About the School of Social Sciences and Languages
