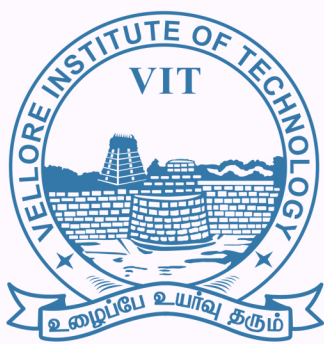

- One-time participation only



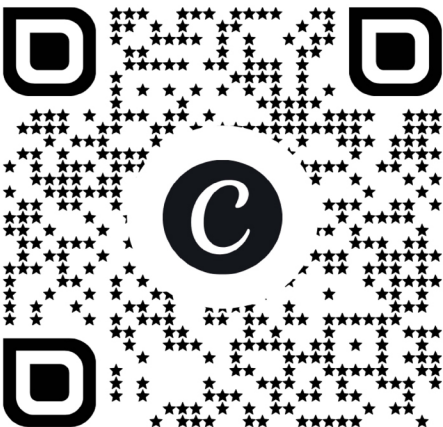
